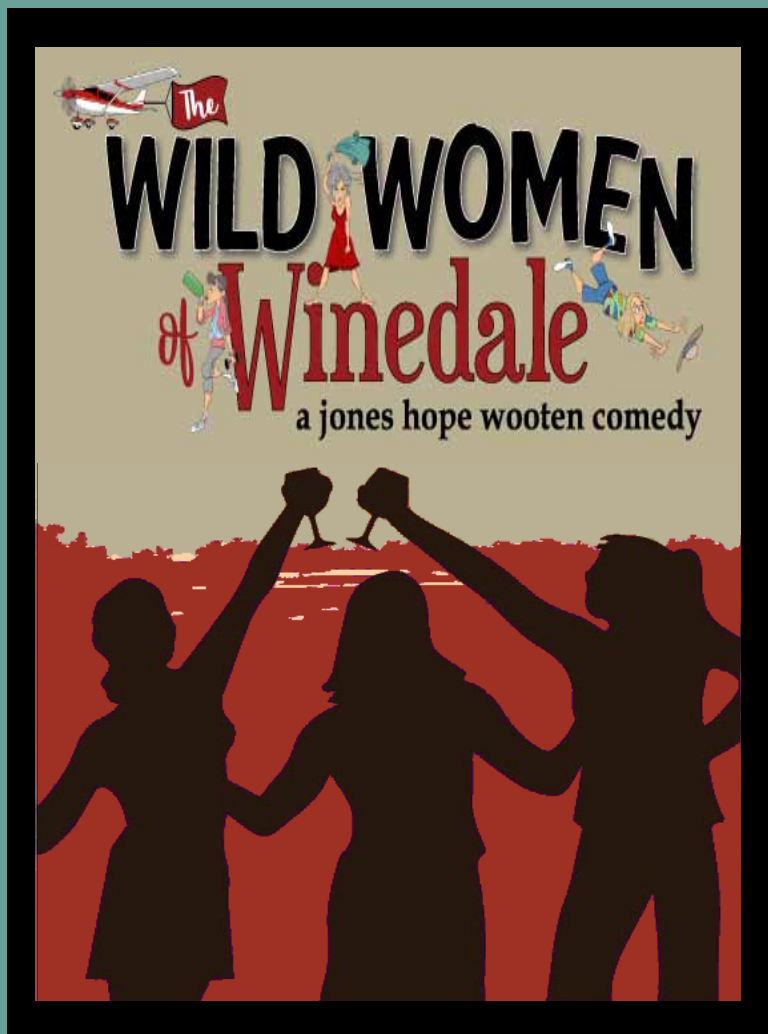

NANCY GRESHAM (Willa Wild) delighted audiences last year as Mama Lily in *Hank Williams Lost Highway*. She has been a part of the family at Main Street since 2003. Favorite roles include Ouiser in *Steel Magnolias*, Grace (2 times) in *Grace and Glorie*, and Mama in *Mama Won't Fly*. In addition to acting, Nancy has directed many Main Street shows, including *The Importance of Being Ernest*, *The Mystery of Irma Vep*, and *Clue, the Musical*. She also directed the first three summer shows for teens. Nancy is a retired educator with 41 years in the classroom. While at a Griffin High School she served as chairman of the Fine Arts Department.



MARIAN SORENSEN (Fanny Wild Cantrelle) is thrilled to be working with Norma and Nancy on this show. Some of her favorite roles at MSP include Grace Bodell in *Fireflies*, Mrs. Dubose in *To Kill A Mockingbird*, Carrie Watts in *A Trip to Bountiful*, Ethel in *On Golden Pond*, and Nita Mooney in *Hallelujah Girls*. She spent many years in the Atlanta area and received her theatrical training at the Alliance Theatre School at the Woodruff Arts Center. While there, she was contracted as a teacher in the acting program and became Assistant Director of the School. Marian has performed and/or directed on the main stage at The Alliance Theatre, The Studio Theatre, Theatrical Outfit, Open City Theatre and Theatre in the Square. She is a retired educator of 32 years and currently works part time with the Griffin-Spalding County School system in Federal Programs. She would like to thank her husband, Neil, for taking care of all the animals while she was "at the beach."



NORMA RICHARDSON (Johnnie Faye Wild) has been involved with theatre for most of her life and has appeared on a number of Atlanta stages among others. On stage productions include: *Fireflies*, *The Lion in Winter*, *The Dixie Swim Club*, *Southern Comforts*, *Driving Miss Daisy*, *Love Letters*, *The Little Foxes*, *The Guys*, *Steel Magnolias*, (2 times) *Grace & Glorie*, and *Same Time Next Year*. As a director her credits include: *Hank Willaiams: Lost Highway*, *The Dixie Swim Club*, *The Mystery of Irma Vep*, *Honky Tonk Highway*, *Nunset Boulevard*, *Inherit the Wind*, *Titanic, the Musical*, *Tuesday's With Morrie*, *Every Christmas Story Ever Told (and Then Some)* 2015 and 2019, *Mama Won't Fly*, and *Our Town*. Her career in television began with Turner Broadcasting/CNN. After leaving Turner, she was an Executive Vice President with Primerica and General Manager for their corporate television production department for over 20 years. She is a native of Griffin, Georgia and is the Founding Artistic Director of Main Street Players.

JANICE AIKEN (Production Assistant) has helped behind the scenes on several productions. Onstage performances include *War of the Worlds: The Panic Broadcast*, *Inherit the Wind* and *To Kill a Mockingbird*. She was recognized at the GAAA Heart for the Arts as Main Street Player's Most Valuable Volunteer for our 2016-2017 season. Janice serves on our board and has been volunteering for Main Street Players since the fall of 2012.

She has been invaluable to our organization and has worked the Box Office, sold concessions, ushered, trained others to usher, answered the phones, helped clean the theatre prior to openings, worked set construction, repaired props and is an integral part of our Theater for Young Audiences program.



REECE BREEDLOVE II (Stagehand) was last seen in last year's production of *Fireflies*. He also played Jimmy Burrhead in *Hank Williams: Lost Highway* last season. He began his stage experience with Studio 54 players at HCHS and continued acting at Columbus State University in numerous roles, including a stint in *The Princess and the Pea*. He has volunteered for Charity Theater with Crosswalk Ministries where he performed in *Cotton Patch Gospel*

and *Godspell*. Reece was last seen on the stage with The Front Porch Players in *Monky Business*. "All that we are, is the result of all that we have thought... currently I am a grilled cheese sandwich."



JASON BROWN (Production Audio and Lighting) is a Griffin native who has been involved in the local arts for a few years. His involvement has included everything from designing programs to being Music Director for a group of students attending Junior Theatre Festival. His passion is working behind the scenes, especially lighting and sound design. He is excited to be working with this talented group of hard working folks at Main Street once again!



CURTIS BROWN (Lighting Design) is a Main Street regular. He has worked with Main Street in some capacity almost every season since 2002. Last year he made his directorial debut with a very successful production of *Holmes and Watson*. He just played multiple roles in *Every Christmas Ever Told (And Then Some!)*. Last year he appeared as Pap in *Hank Williams: Lost Highway*, John in *Lion in Winter*, and Actor #3 in *The Christmas Carol*. Other

roles at MSP include Jane Twisden, Lord Edgar Hillcrest in *The Mystery of Irma Vep*, and Norman Bulansky in *The Boys Next Door*.



FRANK DANSBY (Master Carpenter) was Main Street's most valuable volunteer for the 2018-2019 season. He and his wife, Martha, are lifelong supporters of the arts and in particular theatre. Three years ago Frank joined Resident Scenic Designer BJ Hughes backstage at Main Street Players and quickly became a tremendous asset to the production team. With his background as an

airplane mechanic and his vast knowledge of DIY he quickly picked up on the construction techniques particular to theatre. Frank has worked on twelve productions for Main Street. With his construction and carpentry skills, he has allowed BJ to expand his vision of what our productions can look like, resulting in even more professional looking sets and scenery. BJ HUGHES (Resident Designer) is enjoying his ninth season with Main Street Players. He is even more delighted to be celebrating his 50th anniversary in professional theatre during which he has worked as an actor, teacher, director and designer. After obtaining a degree in theatre he spent four years touring America in classical repertory before settling in Atlanta where for the next 30 years he acted, taught and directed at the Alliance Theatre. 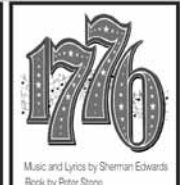

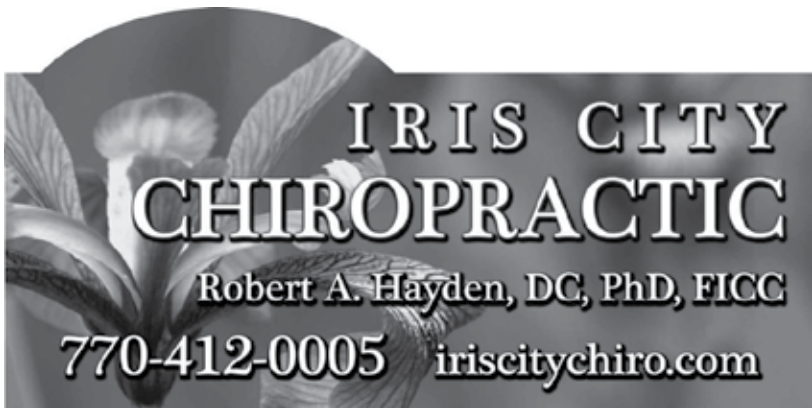
