#### A Message from the Director

#### "Write what you know."

That's the advice most often given to young writers. Neil Simon, American playwright, screenwriter, television writer, librettist and one of the most popular playwrights in the history of American theater obviously took that advice to heart. Throughout his career he wrote over 30 plays, and screenplays for as many films. Many of which are generally semi-autobiographical, including important aspects of his troubled childhood and first marriages. He has said, "I suppose you could practically trace my life through my plays."

Many of Simon's plays are set in New York City, with a resulting urban flavor. Within that setting, his themes include marital conflict, infidelity, sibling rivalry, adolescence, and fear of aging. Despite the serious nature of these ideas, Simon always managed to tell the stories with humor, embracing both realism and comedy. He would tell aspiring comedy writers, "not to try to make it funny ... try and make it real and then the comedy will come. When I was writing plays", he said, "I was almost always writing a drama that was funny ... I wanted to tell a story about real people." His comedy often portrayed struggles with marital difficulties or fading love, sometimes leading to separation and divorce. After many twists in the plot, the endings typically showed renewal of the relationships.


Barefoot in the Park premiered on Broadway over 63 years ago. In the late 1960s it was one of four Simon plays to be running simultaneously in the Big Apple. Sadly, interest in his early works seemed to have waned around the turn of the century. But in the last decade, there has been a renewal of relationships with theatergoers. I'm delighted that Main Street can be part of that, and introduce this delightful comedy to a new audience. With a young cast, and a fresh take I hope we have made it "real" and let the comedy come.
